RENTALS TO OUTSIDE ORGANZIATIONS - CONTRACT TO BE NEGOTIATED

Basic Kiddish - i.e. Coffee and/or Tea, Bagels, Creamcheese Tuna fish or Egg Salad & Pastry

Enhanced Kiddish - i.e. Coffee and/or Tea, Bagels, Creamcheese, Tuna fish or Egg Salad, Salad, Hot Dish & Pastry

Premium Kiddish - i.e. Coffee and/or Tea, Bagels, Lox, Creamcheese, Tuna fish or Egg Salad, Salad, Hot Dish & Pastry

- Definition of members in regards to this Fee Schedule, includes - immediate family, child of member and parent/guardian of member per membership rules
- If non-member wants an outside Rabbi and/or Cantor to officiate at a wedding, Rabbi and/or Cantor will be entitled to standard officiating fees. Rabbi and/or Cantor must be consulted regarding fees. Rabbi has final approval of outside Clergy.
- Security Deposit is due upon contract signing. All MEMBER contracts and fees due must be signed and paid within 30 days of the affair/event date or the affair/event is subject to cancellation. All NON-MEMBER contracts and fees due must be signed and paid within 60 days of the affair/event date or the affair/event is subject to cancellation.
- A cancellation fee equal to 10% of the rental fee will be assessed for any cancellation within 14 days of the scheduled affair/event.
- All Accommodators and Caterers must be approved by the Rabbi.
- Whenever an Accommodator is using the temple kitchen, an approved Mashgiach must be present.
- Any person or organization using the Temple facilities must coordinate the times of setting up the respective function with the Temple office.
- \$250 service fee will be charged if the celebrant desires to bring in rental chairs for the function.
- When both a kiddush and evening function are being held, the kiddush must be paper goods only (if accommodated) and the hall must be vacated by 2:00 pm to allow for proper setup for the evening reception.
- Onegs that last past 11:00 PM will be charged \$100.00 for each additional hour.
- The renter is liable for any damage to the Temple, including its equipment, furniture, and property, caused by the renter, their guests, or invitees during the rental period. The renter agrees to compensate the Temple for repairs or replacements necessary due to such damage, potentially using a security deposit and incurring additional charges if the deposit is insufficient.
- **All event rentals are limited to 4 hours**
